Job Assignment: **WALK MARSHAL TEAM**
Staffed by: Walk Marshals

Arrival Time: 6:00 a.m.
Departure Time: Tentative

OBJECTIVE: Walk Marshal Team will manage the crowd throughout the event walk. This team will be placed throughout the route to direct traffic and help with crowd control under the direction of the Redlands Police Department. **Walk Marshal must be at least 18 years old to participate or 16 and accompanied by an adult.**

WHAT TO BRING:

- Wear comfortable clothes.
 - Dress in layers so you can remove clothing as the day becomes warmer.
 - Bring an umbrella if needed. Wear a hat and use sunscreen.
- **If you attended the Volunteer Check-In on Friday, October 5th (Pathway Church 611 E Cypress Ave, Redlands) you will have your Volunteer t-shirt.** Please be sure to wear it!

UPON ARRIVAL:

- Check in at Ed Hales Park (5th & State Streets), across from the Tartan (24 E. Redlands Blvd, Redlands) at 6:00 a.m. to get your **specific location assignment**, event map & Volunteer t-shirt.
 - As required by the Redlands Police Department and for safety purposes you **MUST** wear your official volunteer t-shirt until you are released from your assigned location.
- Your contact person will be **Marshal Lead, Tiffany Hoekstra Cell (909) 838-5293**
 - You will be working in teams of 2-4 volunteers.
- It is advised you **park near your assigned location after** you have checked-in.

DURING THE EVENT:

BARRICADE SET-UP: *Deadline for barricade set-up & posted at your assigned location: 7:30 a.m.*

- When you reach your assigned location – move the barricade(s) that are set in the vicinity to the street location or intersection.
 - Place the barricade(s) in the middle of the assigned street or intersection.
- Walk Marshals and Walk Participants shall follow the following **rules of the road**:
 - Pedestrians outside Crosswalks CA Code:
 - a. 21954. (a) Every pedestrian upon a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway so near as to constitute immediate hazard
 - **THIS IS NOT A CLOSED COURSE EVENT, ROADWAYS AND STREETS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC- Stay Alert! Your role as a Walk Marshal is vital to our walkers' safety!**
 - Use the assigned "STOP/SLOW" paddles to direct traffic. Stop walkers and allow cars and traffic to continue as needed.
- Provide alternative routes to the Redlands Churches impacted by the route as needed.
- While you have serious responsibilities, remember to **have fun**. Make this a positive and enjoyable experience for the volunteers, walkers, and yourself.

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY:

- American Medical Response Ambulance Services (AMR) is on site at **Registration** and then **moves along the route** behind the walk participants.
- AMR remains on site at the Redlands Bowl until the end of the Believe Bash.
- **If there is an emergency please call 911**

END OF EVENT:

- Move the barricades back to where they were originally located when you arrived.
- Clean up any personal trash.
- You are welcome to join us at the Redlands Bowl for the Believe Bash.

Remain at your post until the walk personnel releases you from your location.
